At Chartwell, the underlying purpose guiding everything we do is Making People's Lives BETTER.

The Chartwell Foundation was launched on October 1, 2022 and established as a national charity to help seniors continue to live a life of purpose, connectedness and engagement through wish granting. The Foundation builds on a five-year partnership between Chartwell and the former charity Wish of a Lifetime Canada from 2015-2020. When Wish of a Lifetime ceased its Canadian operations, Chartwell knew this meaningful mission must continue. The goal of the foundation is to grant as many wishes as possible every year.

What is a Wish?

A Wish holds value beyond a passing desire or casual thought – it is a dream, a lifelong goal, or a meaningful component to one's life that has been missing. A wish could be as simple as taking flight in a hot air balloon, or as extraordinary as reconnecting with a loved one after many decades. A Wish granted makes other goals seem possible and encourages our wish recipients to keep dreaming and pursuing their passions.

The Wish Nominee...

- Must be 65 years of age or older
- Must be a citizen or legal resident of Canada
- Must be unable to fulfill the wish on their own
- Must be physically able to experience the wish
- Must be able to provide written approval to participate from a doctor, if required.
